LOAVES AND FISHES SUNDAY IN NOVEMBER



In November, our church will once again participate in the Cumberland Presbyterian Missions Ministry's Loaves and Fishes offering. Each household will receive a small box, which we fill with coins and bills that will be used to share God's love and to alleviate hunger. This year, our Loaves and Fishes offering will help to feed children in the Me Ama (He Loves Me) after school program, sponsored by the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in Armenia, Colombia. This afterschool program

serves 25 children between ages 6 and 11; many more families are on the waiting list. Children come to the church each week, Monday through Friday, from 2:00 pm to 5:30 pm to receive help with their homework, a daily devotional, and a nutritious snack.

More than half of the children served by the *He Loves Me* program are from families that have fled Venezuela and have experienced great hardship and disruption in their lives. The Armenia Church supports the children in their transition to new schools. A nurse and physician from the church assess their health and provide medical exams, schedule much-needed dental care, and provide dental hygiene kits. The program director and volunteers

are attentive to the children's emotional needs; many of these children were forced to leave behind a parent, grandparents, and other family members when fleeing Venezuela. The children are vulnerable because of the complex situations their families face as they look for employment, a safe place to live, and regular, secure access to food.

The *He Loves Me* after school program began in 2019 with funding from Colombia Kids, a small nonprofit my siblings and I founded in 2015 in memory of our parents. My sister and I visited the afterschool program last year, met with the incredible volunteers, and were delighted to see how the children are being served and loved. With the support of the



denominational Missions Ministry and the Loaves and Fishes offering, our hope is that the program will expand to cover more families and that together we will heed Christ's urging, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." 
