# ALL HAIL THE POWER OF JESUS' NAME

"Who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, angels and authorities and powers having been made subject to Him." 1 Peter 3:22

One of the great and majestic hymns of the church is "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name." This hymn was composed by Rev. Edward Perronet in 1779.

Edward's Protestant grandparents had fled France, first going to Switzerland and then to England to escape religious persecution. Edward's father became a vicar in the Anglican Church, and Edward followed in his footsteps.

Edward was a very close friend of both John and Charles Wesley, founders of the Methodist movement in the Church of England. Edward became pastor of a dissenting congregation and that led to a break with the Wesleys over various Methodists policies. Their differences of opinion resulted in Edwards' hymns being excluded from the Methodists hymnals of their time.

"All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name," has earned Edward Perronet a prominent place in the history of church music. The hymn itself has been of great importance in missionary history, being greatly used in evangelistic endeavors. Missionary E.P. Scott went to India to evangelize. He went out to visit a remote mountain tribe which had never heard about Christ. As he neared their land, he was quickly surrounded by a band of warriors, all pointing their spears at him. Anticipating a quick death, the missionary got out his violin and began playing and singing in their native language the hymn "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name." He got to the stanza that says:

Let every tribe and every tongue on this terrestrial ball To him all majesty ascribe And crown him Lord of all...

The natives lowered their weapons and some were in tears. E.P. Scott spent the rest of his life ministering to these people. The hymn which so effectively moved this Indian tribe is often referred to as the "National Anthem of Christendom" and has been translated into almost every language where there are Christians.

All hail the power of Jesus' name! Let angels prostrate fall; bring forth the royal diadem, and crown Him Lord of all; bring forth the royal diadem, and crown Him Lord of all.
